

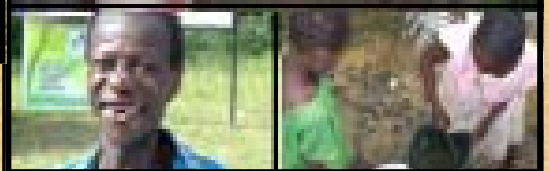

THE VILLAGE OF BEDIASE

Bediase, a Village with a population of about 430 people, is a cocoa farming community with very low economic levels. The village is situated in the Tafo District, 35 km from the District capital. It can hardly boast of social amenities leaving the inhabitant without the most basic amenities, potable water, schools, clinic or recreation center. These people live in mud houses which are in a deplorable state. With joy, the chief and the people of this village welcomed ROAM for the 3 days mission.



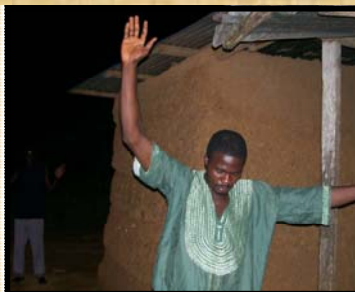
